“LI” Regata del Sol al Sol – April 23 to April 30, 2021

The St. Petersburg Yacht Club, jointly with the Club de Yates de Isla Mujeres, is the Organizing Authority.

Notice of Race

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The following rules will also apply:
- a. IRC 2017 Rating Systems Rule
 - (1) In accordance with IRC Rule 21.6.1(b), a boat may carry one more spinnaker than shown on her current IRC certificate of area not greater than rated SPA without an increase in rating.
 - b. West Florida PHRF Handicap Rule
 - c. ORC 2017 Rule
 - d. Equipment Rules of Sailing.
 - e. The International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea. (IRPCAS)
Part 2 of the Racing Rules of Sailing is replaced by Part B of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea from **1800 to 0630 local time.**
 - f. World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations 2016-2017 Category 2, except as amended below.
 - Each boat shall have sufficient fuel on board, at the start, for running 150 miles.
 - All boats are required to have VHF radios with channels 9, 16, 63, 68, 71, 72, & 77.
 - AIS Transponders are not required but highly recommended.
 - Every vessel entered shall carry the appropriate nautical charts.
 - Each skipper or owner shall declare his or her vessel's eligibility and shall affirm that the vessel complies with any and all equipment requirements for this race.
- 1.3 World Sailing National authority prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2, & 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7
- 1.6 The organizing committee may perform random inspections for compliance of the equipment.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.2 Advertising shall be restricted to World Sailing Advertising Code 20.2.2, 20.2.3.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The race is open to boats at least 30 feet in length, with a current West Florida PHRF (WFPHRF), IRC, and ORC Club Rating. Five or more entries in each rating system will constitute a rating class.
The skipper shall be a current member of a yacht club or sailing organization, and the boat shall have a crew of at least four persons. The skipper and navigator shall be Group 1 competitors as defined in World Sailing 22.2.1.
- 3.2 The skipper is the person in charge of the boat and crew while the boat is racing. Unless otherwise designated on the entry form, the owner will be considered the skipper.
- 3.3 The skipper shall complete documentation forms for his/her boat and crew prior to the skipper's meeting April 22, 2021.
- 3.4 A valid e-mail address is required for entry.
- 3.5 Entries will be limited to 50 boats.
- 3.6 Passports are required for all participants
- 3.7 **No Boat's entry is final without a completed and signed waiver online at yacht scoring for each participating crew member and skipper.**

4. CLASSES

- 4.1 There will be six classes of boats:

PHRF-Spinnaker
 PHRF-Non-Spinnaker
 PHRF-Cruising
 PHRF-Multihull
 ORC
 IRC

Double-handed Class
 Racer/Cruiser

Motor-Sailing Class (More information regarding this class will be posted soon.)

- 4.2 Classes may be divided into two or more divisions. If a class does not have enough entrants, these boats will be placed in the appropriate WFPHRF Class/Division by the organizing authority.

4.3 Cruising spinnakers are permitted for the Cruising Class.

4.4 All Cruiser entrants shall declare their intent to use a cruising-spinnaker by midnight, Monday, April 19, 2021 by E-mailing the chairman@regatadelsolalsol.org

5. ENTRY FEES & ELIGIBILITY

5.1 Boat Entry Fees schedule is as follows

\$695.00 for boat entries postmarked, filed online, and paid by January 31, 2021

\$795.00 for boat entries postmarked, filed online, and paid between February 1, 2021 to March 28, 2021

\$895.00 for boat entries postmarked, filed online, and paid after March 29, 2021 up to April 5, 2021

The Final Entry and Payment Deadline is Monday, April 5, 2021.

5.2 Entry fees include the Mexican government fees and customs charges (subject to change), a transponder rental fee, & six regatta shirt (1 Skipper Shirt-5 Crew shirts)

5.3 Skipper/Crew Fees Per Person

\$150.00 – This fee includes Mexican Visa Fee & 1 Event Armband (SPYC activities & All Regata Events in Mexico.)

Skipper/ Crew/ Fees Final deadline is Monday, April 5, 2021.

5.4 The Skipper or designee shall make only one payment for Vessel, Skipper and, all Crew members.

See "Other Information" at the end of this document for Reporting Complimentary Shirt Sizes and the method of ordering and paying for extra shirts, armbands and SPYC dinner tickets.

5.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form on the Regata del sol al Sol or SPYC websites. www.regatadelsolalsol.org or www.spyc.org. On line entries must send copy of current of rating certificate via email to chair@regatadelsolalsol.org or c/o SPYC/Regata del Sol al Sol by regular mail to 11 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg Florida, 33701.

If not entering online, Entry form, a current copy of a valid 2021 Rating Certificate and a check made payable to "SPYC/Regata del Sol al Sol 2020" should be sent to the Event Chair Elizabeth Pennington, SPYC/Regata del Sol al Sol by regular mail at 11 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg, FL, 33701.

5.6 Entries will not be accepted after April 5, 2021.

5.7 Withdrawals

5.8(a) Boats that have entered and withdraw, in writing, prior to 2300 March 22, 2021, will receive a refund of their entry fee less a \$200 processing fee. Boats withdrawing after 2300 March 22, 2021 and before 2300 April 5, 2021 will receive a refund less a \$500.00 processing fee. After April 2300 April 6, 2020, no refunds will be given.

5.8(a) Skipper or Crew that withdraw, in writing, prior to 2300 March 22, 2021, will receive a refund of their entry fee less a \$50.00 processing fee. Crew or Skipper withdrawing after 2300 March 22, 2021 and before 2300 April 5, 2021 will receive a refund less a \$75.00 processing fee. After April 2300 April 5, 2021, no refunds will be given.

5.9 If any extra skipper or crew shirts are ordered, there is no refund.

6. DOCKAGE

6.1 At SPYC: All reservations for dockage before the event must be made with the SPYC Dockmaster (727- 822-3227) or e-mail to dockmaster@spyc.org Reservation information will follow.

6.2 At Isla Mujeres: All reservations for dockage must be requested on the entry form and will be handled by the organizing authorities in Mexico, and will have the final say as to dock assignments.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Preliminary sailing Instructions when available will be posted on the website at www.regatadelsolalsol.org

Final sailing instructions will be available at registration.

9. THE COURSE

9.1 From the starting line in the vicinity of the St. Petersburg Pier,

- southerly to the "C" Cut Lower Range tower (Iso R 6s 56ft PA- (N 27° 39.81' W 82° 37.18') leaving it to starboard;
- southwesterly, through the three center span piers and associated fenders of the Sunshine Skyway Bridge;
- out Southwest Pass, leaving flashing buoy "1" (FL 2.5 sec) bell to port;
- to the finish line off Isla Mujeres, maintaining a distance of at least 15 miles off the coast of Cuba at all times.

9.2 The course will not be shortened **after** the start and the finishing line will not be moved. This changes RRS 32.1. The location of the finish line will be within ½ mile of this position: N 21° 16.707" N -- W 86° 45.329".

9.3 Mexican authorities require all boats, which are planning to enter Mexico, to cross the finish line in order to record the time of their entry into the country, even if they have withdrawn from the race.

9.4 The rated distance for this race will be 456 miles. This distance is not subject to protests or requests for redress. This changes RRS 62.1.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3 will apply. The penalty will be the number of places nearest to 20% of the number of boats entered in a class, or in a division if the class has been divided.

11. SAFETY

11.1 The safety of a boat and its crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Skipper, who must ensure that the boat is fully sound, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by experienced crew who are physically fit. The Skipper of the boat must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails and all gear, and must ensure all equipment is properly maintained and stowed, and that all aboard know where it is kept and how it is used.

11.2 It is strongly recommended that at least one person has completed the **USSA Course "Safety at Sea Seminar."**

12. COMMUNICATIONS

12.1 All boats shall carry transponders. The rental fee for the transponders is included in the entry fee. Information about the transponders will be sent to each skipper. The Regatta organizer will provide an agreement form for the transponders, where by the skipper agrees to be responsible for the replacement cost of the transponder should they lose, damage, or not return the transponder in the manner described in the agreement. This agreement will state skipper name, vessel name, final date of return, and current credit card information.

12.2 From the time of their preparatory signal until they have finished or withdrawn from the race, competitors may not receive weather, current, or navigational information except from a publicized source available to all competitors free of charge. This restriction also applies to boat-to-boat transmissions for routing purposes.

12.3 General use of the Internet and publicly available web sites to obtain weather and Gulf of Mexico current information including National Weather Service data is permitted. Weather routing data developed specifically for the race may not be received while racing.

12.4 Protests alleging infringement of Notice of Race Part 13 shall only be initiated by the race committee. This changes RRS 60.1.

13. Scoring:

Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply, except that no score will be excluded. This Changes Appendix A2. Corrected times will be based on the boat's WFPHRF, ORC, or IRC rating and using a course distance of 456 nautical miles.

Perpetual Trophies are the property of the St. Petersburg Yacht Club and Isla Mujeres Yacht Club. After the awards presentation has been completed all trophies must be returned to the trophy table.

15. Disclaimer of Liability and Personal Conduct

15.1 Competitor has read RRS4, Decision to Race, and acknowledges the risks to life, limb and property inherent in competitive sailing and assumes those risks. Competitor for himself/herself and his/her crew, their heirs, personal representatives and assigns, hereby releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue the St Petersburg Yacht Club, The Club d Yates Isla Mujeres, its officers, members, sponsors, employees, volunteers, race officials and agents, and each of them (the "Releasees"), for all loss or damage, and any claim of damage therefor, on account of injury to the person or property or resulting death, whether caused by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise, both ashore or at sea, as a consequence of participation in Regatta activities.

15.2 The Skipper/Owner of each boat participating in the Regatta shall be responsible for the behavior of each member of the crew of his/her boat both on the water and while ashore. The failure of any of those persons to comply with all federal, state, and local government regulations as well as the St Petersburg Yacht Club policies or with any reasonable request of the Organizing Authority, Race Officers, or their representatives may result in the disqualification of the boat and its exclusion from the regatta. This modifies RRS 76.
