An additional \$35 (subject to change) Immigration Tourist Visa Fee per crew member must be paid for each person entering Mexico by boat. More information will follow concerning this fee.

Entry Fee Schedule

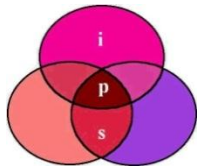
\$900 January 31, 2014

Final entry deadline is April 6, 2013 – No entries will be accepted after this date.
