\$900 now through December 31, 2014

The Entry fee includes \$350 Mexican government fees and customs charges, transponder rental, six regatta shirts and six regatta event tickets.

An additional \$35 (subject to change) Immigration Tourist Visa Fee per crew member must be paid for each person entering Mexico by boat.
